SUPPORT FOR SPINAL INJURY RESEARCH

At the 2020 AGM Campaign for Samuel Inc. approved a donation of \$2000 to support the Perry Cross Foundation Spinal Research [Intensive Rehabilitation Trial](#) as part of the Clem Jones Centre for Neurobiology and Stem Cell Research - Spinal Injury Project. This donation is in line with the objectives of the association to support research into treatment for spinal cord injury.

EDUCATION

Samuel has worked well in all of his subjects. His efforts in his studies are reflected in his results. At the recent 2020 Annual School Awards Ceremony, Samuel received an Academic Excellence Award, the Year 9 Mathematics, Science and Social Sciences Awards and 2020 Junior School Dux! Samuel had set a goal of gaining Dux this year and he worked towards this with every assessment. (This goal would have nothing to do with a competition with his sister Amelia, who also achieved Junior Dux.)

His subjects for 2021 will include Year 10 English, Maths and History, Year 11 Legal Studies and Certificate 3 in Aviation (Remote Pilot) - drone flying / remote pilot license. The school has continued to work with Samuel and give him the options he needs to make the learning relative to his needs. How wonderful not to have to complete another semester of Health and Physical Education practical component! Not doing this subject will allow him a little extra time to complete work for his subjects, that typically takes longer than his peers to complete.

Home Modification discussions have commenced with the specialised Occupational Therapist. It'll be a long process, but at least it has begun. How wonderful to have the Trivia Night funds from the last two years to contribute towards this area for Samuel to access. The aim is to convert the back area of the house into an accessible and welcoming area for use by Samuel.

HEALTH

Despite the COVID Pandemic, Samuel has maintained good health. He had a recent surgery and overnight admission for a check on his tracheostomy stoma and also a bronchoscopy. Great news that the stoma was looking good and his lungs are looking very healthy. What a blessing!

Every week Samuel has physiotherapy at home on the cycling machine with functional electrode stimulation (FES) on his leg muscles or standing on the tilt table. Bone density strength is vital and load bearing is perfect to help this. Samuel has reached the limits of the tilt table which has been a goal for 3 years! Now he'll work on extending the time he is standing at this level. Awesome!

Samuel was invited by Sporting Wheelies and Disabled Association to join them at Parliament House, where he met Minister Mick DeBrenni and Education Minister Grace Grace, and helped advocate with Sporting Wheelies & Disabled Association for inclusive Paralympic sports to be played in all schools.
